






General Features of the Test

(plus 10 minutes' transfer time).

Questions: There are 40 questions



4 Sections

Each section only heard once heard.

A variety of voices and native-speaker accents are used.

There are 6 different tasks for the test.

- Task type 1 Multiple choice.
- Task type 2 Matching.
- Task type 3 Plan, map, diagram labelling.
- Task type 4 Form, note, table, flow-chart, summary completion.




There are two writing tasks and BOTH must be completed.

Task 1 - They need to write 150 words in about 20 minutes.

Task 2 - They need to write 250 words in about 40 minutes.

Examiners use assessment criteria to award a band score for each of the four criteria:

- Task Achievement (for Task 1), Task Response (for Task 2).
- Coherence and Cohesion.
- Lexical Resource.
- Grammatical Range and Accuracy.





IELTS General Training Writing

Task types	In Task 1 . Test takers are asked to respond to a situation, for example, by writing a letter requesting information or explaining a situation. In Task 2 . Test takers write an essay to a point of view, argument or problem.
Answering	Answers must be written in full in the answers booklet. Notes or bullet points in whole or in part are not acceptable as answers. Test takers may write on the questions paper but this cannot be taken from the test room and will not be seen by the examiner.

Speaking Academic and General

Paper format	The speaking test consists of an oral interview between the test takers' and the examiner. All speaking tests are recorded.
Timing	11 – 14 minutes
No. of questions	There are three parts to the test and each part fulfils a specific function in terms of interaction pattern, task input and test takers output.

Examiners use assessment criteria to award a band score for each of the four criteria:

- Fluency and Coherence.
- Lexical Resource.
- Grammatical Range and Accuracy.
- Pronunciation.

Where is IELTS offered?

- Over 1,600 location around the world (and growing...).
- IELTS nearest testing location centre.
- Regular testing dates each month for the IELTS. They don't have everyday exam, it's also limited.
- Every two weeks, they have an exam, so the student should book two weeks in advanced.


Understanding IELTS Score

Some examples:

	Listening	Reading	Writing	Speaking	Average of four components (total of the four individual component scores divided by four)	Band score
Test taker A	6.5	6.5	5.0	7.0	6.25	6.5
Test taker B	4.0	3.5	4.0	4.0	3.875	4.0
Test taker C	6.5	6.5	5.5	6.0	6.125	6.0

- IELTS band score from 0-9 for each test section
- IELTS Test Report Form will show a score for each of the four skills (Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking) and an overall band score. You can score whole band scores (for example 5.0, 6.0, 7.0) or half band scores (e.g. 5.5, 6.5, 7.5) in every section of the test.







Academic Test Takers: Mean Performance by Gender




General Training Test Takers: Mean Performance by Gender

What is TOEFL

Test of English as a Foreign Language

Established in 1964 – 56 years ago.

TOEFL scores are a requirement for over 900 universities and other institutions in more than 130 countries.

It is an English proficiency test, developed by an American company, ETS (Educational Testing Service) to measure an individual's.

- Listening.
- Reading.
- Writing.
- Speaking.

Reading



- Time:54–72 minutes.
- Question: 30–40 questions
- Consists of questions on 3-4 passages.
- Each approximately 700 words in length and with 10 questions.
- The passages are on academic topics.
- Passages require understanding of rhetorical functions such as cause-effect, compare-contrast and argumentation.
- Students answer questions about main ideas.
- <u>Test Content.</u>

Speaking



Time: 17 minutes. **Question:** 4 tasks

Consists of 4 tasks:

- 1 independent (Task 1)
- 3 integrated (Task 2, 3, 4).

In task 1, test-takers answer opinion questions on familiar topics. They are evaluated on their ability to speak spontaneously and convey their ideas clearly and coherently.

In task 2 and 4, test-takers read a short passage, listen to an academic course lecture or a conversation about campus life.

In task 3, test-takers listen to an academic course lecture and then respond to a question about what they heard.

Test Content.

Writing



Time: 50 minutes

Question: 2 tasks.

Writing section measures a test taker's ability to write in an academic setting.

Consists of two tasks:

- 1. One integrated.
- 2. One independent.

In the integrated task, test-takers read a passage on an academic topic and then listen to a speaker discuss it.

In the independent task, the test-taker must write an essay that states their opinion or choice, and then explain it.

Test Content.

Listening



Time: 41–57 minutes

Question: 28–39 questions

- 3–4 lectures, each 3–5 minutes long, with 6 questions per lecture
- 2–3 conversations with 2 speakers, each 3 minutes long, with 5 questions per conversation
- Each conversation and lecture passage is heard only once.
- Test-takers may take notes while they listen and they may refer to their notes when they answer the questions.



Reading Comprehension (55 minutes)

Reading Comprehension sections has 50 questions.

Writing (30 minutes)

Test of Written English (TWE).

One essay question with 250–300 words in average.
